Dear Parents:

I would like to update you on our efforts to provide H1N1 immunization clinics for K-12 students in the Tustin Unified School District.

We have been working very hard to start our immunization clinics by now. However, due to slower than anticipated production of the vaccine, it appears the first opportunity to support a clinic for students will be in early December. Once we receive confirmation from the Orange County Public Health Care Agency, we will send information to you. If there is a chance for your children to receive the H1N1 vaccine and/seasonal flu vaccine through your family physician or other clinic, please take advantage of that opportunity.

In the meantime, we all need to stay vigilant, wash hands frequently and keep your child home if he or she becomes ill. We are continuing to keep common areas in the schools clean and supplying disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer in our classrooms. Together we can get through the flu season with minimal health issues for our students.
