University of California Universities will be "test-optional" for fall 2021 and fall 2022. Freshman applicants are not required to submit SAT/

ACT test scores. What does "test-optional" mean? You choose whether or not to submit SAT/ACT scores with your application. If you are unable or chose not to submit test scores, your application will still receive full consideration.

The California State University (CSU) will temporarily suspend the use of ACT/SAT examinations in determining admission eligibility for all CSU campuses for the 2021-2022 academic year. Click HERE for more information.

ter. To become a member of CSF, you must complete the CSF form found here for Spring of 2020 and email it as an attachment to Mr. Lopez at aalopez@tustin.k12.ca.us. Please read these directions before you fill out the form. You must also pay the membership fee of \$7 through our student store website. Students who wish to graduate with seal bearer status must qualify for 4 semesters from grades 10-12 and at least ONE qualifying semester of MUST be earned during your senior year. PSAT: Each year, TUSD administers the PSAT to all 11th grade students. This is a FREE practice SAT given to all 11th grade students. Participation in the exam not only gives you practice for the SATs and gives you results so you know what to study, but it also makes you eligible for many scholarships including the National Merit Scholarship. This year, due to safety protocols, the ${\bf PSAT}$ will only be offered to 11th grade students who register for the exam. The exam will take place at Beckman High School. All physical distancing protocols will be in place to ensure a safe testing environment.

- Test Date: 10/17/2020
- Location: Beckman High School
- Time: Report time in the morning will vary so that we can stagger arrival time to maintain safety
