The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires State and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Tustin Unified School District hereby adopts the terms of the Fair Political Practices Commission's Standard Conflict of Interest Code found at 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 (the "Code"). The Code and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission will hereby be incorporated by reference and, along with the Appendix, included in the District Administrative Regulations, in which Board Members and employees are designated and disclosure categories set forth, constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Tustin Unified School District.
