## TUSD Seeks Applicants for Measure L Citizens' Oversight Committee

---

The Tustin Unified School District is seeking applicants for its Measure L Citizens' Oversight Committee.

Last November, Measure L, the District's \$95 million bond measure, passed with nearly 60 percent of voters supporting the initiative.

The TUSD Board of Education will appoint a committee to inform the public regarding the expenditure of Measure L's proceeds for school construction.

The committee will consist of at least seven members, including a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District; a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District and active in a parent-teacher organization such as a PTA, PTO or school-site council; an individual who is active on a business organization within the District; a person who is active in a senior citizens' organization; and an individual who is active in a bonafide taxpayers association.

The oversight committee may also engage in activities such as receive and review copies of performance and financial audits, and inspect school facilities and grounds.
