SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

SENIORS - CLASS OF 2018

As we begin to wind down the year and college decisions are made, keep in mind that final transcripts must be ordered via [Parchment](#). Keep in mind that you can order your transcripts now and request that they be sent after grades are finalized in June. The earlier you order, the faster your transcript will be processed. Remember when you place the order to select "hold for grades" so that the final transcript is sent AFTER grades are finalized. Click [HERE](#) for a step-by-step guide and video tutorial that will assist you with the process.

Order your final transcript now

Do you know where you'll be sending your transcript when your final grades are in?

If the answer is yes, then place your order now. Your transcript won't be sent until your final grades are on it. Why wait?

TO ORDER YOUR FINAL TRANSCRIPT:

1. [Sign in](#) to your Parchment account.
 - If you forgot your password, no problem! Simply click the [Forgot Password](#) link to reset it.
 - If you don't have a Parchment account yet, [create an account now](#).

2. Click [Order](#).

3. Search for the destination that you want to send your final transcript to. When you find it, click [Select](#).



4. Under [When do you want this sent?](#), select [Hold for Grades](#). This means the transcript won't be sent until this semester's grades are on it. Click [Save & Continue](#). You'll click [Save & Continue](#) again after reviewing your order.

5. Give consent and click [Save & Continue](#). On the next screen, you'll enter payment information and you're done!

JUNIORS - CLASS OF 2019

Research how to apply to the colleges, majors and certificate programs you are interested in. Check the individual college websites to see the application requirements and how to apply. REQUESTING COLLEGE DOCUMENTS AND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Counselors will accept packets beginning July 31, 2018. **Please do not submit these forms to the counselors before July 31, 2018.**

If students are requesting that a teacher write a Letter of Recommendation, students must contact that teacher directly. If a teacher accepts, then students need to invite them to submit a letter of recommendation and teacher form in [Naviance](#). Students will not be able to invite their teacher on Naviance until July 2018.

Students can begin to submit their completed packets to the counseling office July 31, 2018

Students need to submit the documents below to your counselor before **August 17, 2018** if you are applying to a college/university that has a deadline before December 2, 2018.

Students need to submit the documents below to your counselor before **October 17, 2018** if you are applying to a college/university that has a deadline after December 2, 2018.

1. BHS College/Career Plan (Document on [Counseling HAIKU](#) 11th and 12th grade pages)
2. Printed Updated Colleges I am Applying to List from Naviance (include community colleges, CSU, UC, out of state colleges and private colleges) with the correct deadlines (Print from your Naviance account)
3. Transcript Agreement Form (Document on Counseling HAIKU 11th and 12th grade pages)
4. Updated Resume
5. Updated Student Questionnaire (Document on Counseling HAIKU 11th grade page)
6. Updated Parent Questionnaire (Document on Counseling HAIKU 11th grade page)

The deadline to add colleges to your Naviance list is November 2, 2018. After this date please see your counselor in person to discuss options for adding additional colleges to your list.

SOPHOMORES - CLASS OF 2020

You will need to take the SAT and/or ACT for college admission sometime during your junior year so get a headstart this summer by taking a [free practice SAT test](#) on the CollegeBoard website. The ACT offers [practice options](#) as well.

FRESHMEN - CLASS OF 2021

Prepare and study for final exam week June 4 -7. Look into internships, summer programs and community service to strengthen your academic resume. Check Aeries to see if you have any classes you need to enroll in for summer school. Create a list of colleges to visit over the summer.
