Dear Parent/Student:

TUSD Connect is expanding technology further during the 2014-15 school year with the issuance of Toshiba Laptops to all high school students. As part of this rollout, a district issued case is provided for each laptop device. If students prefer they may supply their own case or sleeve to protect the laptop. A student furnished case must provide adequate protection for the laptop and be approved by district staff **prior** to the student being issued a laptop.

To ensure the utmost protection of the laptop, an approved case must provide adequate padding for the Toshiba laptop which measures 12.4" wide x 8.9" long x .62" thick. To assist you in finding a personalized case, a few district approved models are outlined below. If purchasing a case or sleeve, these styles demonstrate the padding required for approval.

For students who would like to use their own sleeve, please bring it with you to laptop distribution day at which time it will be evaluated. If you are unsure if the case is going to be approved, we suggest retaining the receipt until the case is approved. No refunds will be issued from the School District for unapproved cases.

Laptops must always be transported in an approved case or sleeve to avoid damaging the equipment. Students are ultimately responsible for device security, and no case can prevent 100% damage to a laptop.

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
